We jury new members a few times a year to either fill immediate openings or to create a waiting list. If you are placed on a waiting list you will fill the next opening in your medium. You will be juried on 5 pieces of your work, which should be complete and gallery ready. Your work will be juried by an outside source. A gallery member will also interview you. If you would like to have more than one medium in the gallery, then you need to submit 5 pieces from each medium.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE GALLERY

Membership fee is \$75

Rent is \$75 a month

New Members are required to pay 2 months rent plus the membership fee

Sales will be subject to a 15% commission payable to the gallery

Two dimensional work is entitled to 144 inches

Three dimensional work is entitled to 12 square feet

Artists are required to work 2 shifts of 4 hours each per month

There are a limited number of non-working positions

Artists hang 1/3 new work each month

The gallery is re-hung each month on the Sunday before 1st Thursday

Joining the gallery requires a mandatory 6 month commitment

Joining a co-operative gallery is a commitment that requires your participation. You could be asked to work on committees, attend meeting and at times commit to special projects. There are no guarantees when it comes to your selling, some artists start selling right away, and others don't sell for months. When you join you must look at the big picture instead of short term benefits. Regard your membership as ownership in a business and your monthly rent as fixed cost.

There are benefits in membership beyond sales. When you become a part of our gallery, you will make contacts and gain information about artistic opportunities and also be surrounded by the art community. Your work is being seen and you are becoming known, and as you continue to produce new work your art will evolve and grow. You could do a one person show at the gallery or you could be given the opportunity to participate in our airport gallery.
